The set price for training at the scheduled NSW training dates are as follows, however the cost of training for coaches organising other non-scheduled dates for an **OSSCA Annual Proficiency Certificate** with an APOLA Regional Trainer may be higher with groups of less than 8.

Ocean Safety Surf Coach Award (OSSCA) Annual Proficiency Assessment

Introduction

The **Ocean Safety Surf Coach Award (OSSCA)** was developed in the mid 1990s in consultation with **Surfing Australia** to enable surf coaches access to best practice skills in **rescue and emergency care** as an essential component required for attaining accredited Surf Coach qualifications. The OSSCA Annual Proficiency Assessment provides surf coaches an opportunity to retain currency in knowledge, skills and understandings for effective safe practice in the delivery of open water and surf programs.

The **OSSCA has a currency of 12 months** and annual recertification includes completing a timed pool swim, ocean mission, simulated in-water rescues and a written paper. Surf coaches successfully completing the following shall be issued with an **Ocean Safety Surf Coach Award Annual Proficiency Certificate**.

OSSCA Annual Proficiency Requirements

- Current **Provide First Aid** certificate
- Proficiency in **surfcraft riding** (either surfboard, bodyboard, wave ski, stand-up paddle)
- Completion of the surf coach instruction program or participation in an annual assessment day involving in-water practical and written theory component

OSSCA Competencies Assessment

- APOLA Assessor and Workplace Trainers have extensive professional ocean lifeguard and/or surf coach experience and reserve the right to prevent prospective candidates commencing the practical activity if prospective candidates present themselves as incapable of meeting fitness demands.

Practical

- **Swim 500m** in a pool in a time less than 10 minutes (in a pool minimum length of 25m)
- Complete an **Ocean Mission** over a set course commencing with 300m swim, followed by 300m beach run, followed by 300m surfcraft paddle and concluding with a 300m beach run. Performance indicators include demonstrated skill in negotiating and riding the surf, continuous (no stopping) activity and a recorded time for comparison with other candidates
- Demonstrate **surfcraft rescues** in small to moderate surf using personal surfcraft including paddle to rescue an unconscious and/or conscious patient demonstrating **patient approach, side-by-side, rollover, duck-dive** and **leg-hook** patient pick-up techniques as well as **patient return** with care including DRSABCD assessment.

Theory

- Participate in an **audio-visual presentation and/or interactive discussion** and complete a **written paper** on knowledge, skills and understandings about the role of surf coaches including content on aspects of fitness, beach and ocean environments including weather, ocean rescue techniques, risk management, responsibilities and regulations to do with delivering instruction programs in public open space and meeting student safety, learning and medical needs, and as well understanding of the role of ocean lifeguards, other water safety personnel and strategies for effective emergency management.
