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Provide first aid and Provide CPR courses are aligned to the National Vocational Framework and are delivered by assessor and workplace trainers from a nominated registered training organization (RTO).

The cost of training at the fixed training dates are as follows, however the cost of training for all **other dates** with APOLA Registered Trainers **may be higher when group sizes are less than 8**.

Fixed surf coach training day rates - Surf coach OSSCA Annual Proficiency Certificate **\$99 (or \$77 recertification)**. Provide First Aid (currency 3 years) **\$154 (or \$143 at package rate)**, Provide CPR (currency 1 year) **\$66**. **Discount package rates** - OSSCA with Provide First Aid **\$220**, OSSCA with Provide CPR **\$143**.

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Ocean Safety Surf Coach Award (OSSCA)

Annual Proficiency Certificate

Introduction

The Ocean Safety Surf Coach Award (OSSCA) was developed in consultation with **Surfing Australia** in the mid 1990s to provide surf coaches with access to best practice aquatic rescue and emergency care training. Coaches attaining the OSSCA Annual Proficiency Certificate have currency in the necessary knowledge, skills and understandings required to delivery open water surfcraft riding programs.

The **OSSCA** has a currency of 12 months and annual proficiency assessment includes 500m pool swim, ocean mission, simulated in-water rescues and a written paper. Surf coaches successfully completing the following shall be issued with an **Ocean Safety Surf Coach Award Annual Proficiency Certificate**.

OSSCA Annual Proficiency Assessment Requirements

- Current **Provide First Aid**
- Proficiency in **surfcraft riding** (either surfboard, bodyboard, wave ski, stand-up paddle)
- Completion of the OSSCA surf coach instruction program or annual proficiency assessment day.

OSSCA Competencies Assessment

APOLA Assessor and Workplace Trainers have extensive professional ocean lifeguard and/or surf coach experience and reserve the right to prevent prospective candidates commencing the practical components if prospective candidates present themselves as incapable of meeting fitness demands required for the annual proficiency assessment day.

Practical

- **Swim 500m** in a pool in a time less than 10 minutes (in a pool minimum length of 25m)
- Complete an **Ocean Mission** over a set course commencing with 300m swim, followed by 300m beach run, followed by 300m surfcraft paddle and concluding with a 300m beach run demonstrating skill in negotiating and riding the surf and continuous (non stop) activity
- Demonstrate **surfcraft rescues** in small to moderate surf using personal surfcraft including paddle to rescue an unconscious and/or conscious patient demonstrating **patient approach, side-by-side, rollover, duck-dive and leg-hook** patient pick-up techniques as well as **patient return** with care including DRSABCD assessment.

Theory

- Participate in an **interactive discussion** and complete a **written paper** on knowledge, skills and understandings about the role of surf coaches including fitness, the beach and ocean environment, risk management, land management regulations, instruction strategies that meet student learning and medical needs, ocean rescue techniques and an understanding of the role of ocean lifeguards, other water safety personnel and site-specific aspects for effective emergency management.
